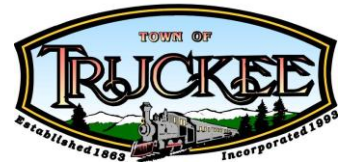




Community Discount Spay/Neuter Program

The Community Spay/Neuter Program is a subsidized program to spay/neuter dogs and cats.

Qualification Guidelines:

- **You must permanently reside within the Town of Truckee or live in Sierra County (Sierra County residents must use Plumas Vet in Beckworth.)**
- Your income level must be at or below the Nevada County median income level for your household size (you can access this information on our website at www.hstf.org or call us at 530.587.5948).
- You must mention that you are participating in this program when you make your appointment with the veterinarian.

Additional Information:

- Each fee is good for one spay or neuter surgery only. Fees for additional procedures, tests or other administrative costs are your responsibility. **You must check with your veterinarian regarding additional expenses when you make your appointment.**
- Because of age or illness, some animals may not be appropriate candidates for spaying or neutering. You should consult with your veterinarian about the suitability of your pet for surgery.
- All surgery, including spay/neuter surgery, can be risky. Complications, including injury or death of the animal can occur. It is your responsibility to talk to your veterinarian about this prior to your appointment.

Your Fees:

- **Cats: \$35**
- **Dogs: \$50**
